All entries must be on a current ASCA entry form. Juniors must use a separate entry.
All entries must be completed (with agreement signed on back) or they will be refused.
Dogs 6 months & over must have ASCA Registration number on entry form

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA

ASCA sanction pending – events will be held under current rules and regulations of ASCA

Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the show committee, ASCA, the show veterinarian or the judge
